FACULTY	93%felt that the syllabus satisfies the criteriaoutline -namely need based course content. However 5% suggested topic for add – on courses especially keeping in view the advancements in technology research and career orientation
STUDENTS	85-92% of the students felt the syllabus is custom-made for current scenario in relation to the competencies expected out of the course .4% suggested inclusion of topics on evidence based treatment and dental ethics
EMPLOYER	89-94% felt that the curriculum content satisfied the needs of students both in theory and clinical aspects as due importance was given to prepare the students for the using demands of competency
ALUMNI	86-92% felt the curriculum is adequate. However they suggested inclusion of more community oriented programs so as to endeavor the students with knowledge on organizing and conducting screening camps
PROFESSIONAL	94% of the professionals felt the curriculum and syllabi content was need based, with active participation from the students community.4%emphasized the inclusion of student oriented clinical training so as to equip them with current methodologies pertaining to patient care


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ACTION TAKEN ON FEEDBACK REPORT 2019-2020

Feedback reports received from the stakeholders were analysed. Most of the students and faculty were felt the curriculum and syllabus is satisfactory. Student felt that courses related to ethics and evidence based dentistry to be incorporated in the curriculum. Departments have been advised to address these issues, plan to conduct these programs in the near future. Screening camps are also planned to be conducted for the general public to create awareness regarding dental diseases.
